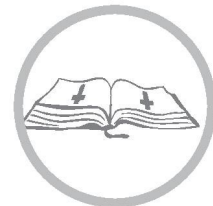

## YOUR COMMITMENT

Because of the intensity of the program, the commitment that we require from you is serious. Much time and effort has been invested in preparing everything for this summer. Not only will we ask you to commit to us, but we will commit the following to you:

- 2) Structured and biblical pattern of Discipleship
- 3) Opportunities to share in your faith and serve

## STUDENT MINISTRY INTERN

As part of the summer staff at CCV, interns will be expected to keep regular hours, attend regularly scheduled student ministry staff meetings and adhere to and obey all policies and guidelines that govern the ministry staff at Christ Church Vienna. There will also be opportunity to assist in leading student missions outreach during the summer and other activities and events as they develop for the upcoming summer.

We consider these leadership roles to be very important and will require commitment and drive for excellence. The leadership at Christ Church Vienna as well as families of the students at CCV commit to offering an environment where the Gospel of Jesus Christ can be lived out and shared for the benefit of all and we hope and pray that consideration and participation in this internship is prayerfully considered. We will be joining you in praying for this to be a great summer of challenge, personal growth and for the students in Vienna to hear and see the Gospel lived out.

## COLLEGE DISCIPLESHIP

**Book Study & Discussion-** This book study will select 2-3 classics and more recent works by Christian authors. Readings will be completed by participants during the week and culminate in a weekly discussion.

**Group Bible Study-** This bible study will be a deeper study of one book of the Bible; looking at historical context and meaning and application for today.

**Group Dinner-** Each week C.D.P. participants will take turns preparing a meal that will be shared with the C.D.P. Group, enjoying the fellowship of this common meal.

**Social Justice/ Christ in Culture-** These cyclical gatherings will give you contact and discussion with believing men and women who see their faith being integral to their work in and through some of our nation's most effective organizations seeking social justice and Gospel transformation. Organizations like the International Justice Mission, Department of justice and International Media Outlets will be highlighted.

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## general overview

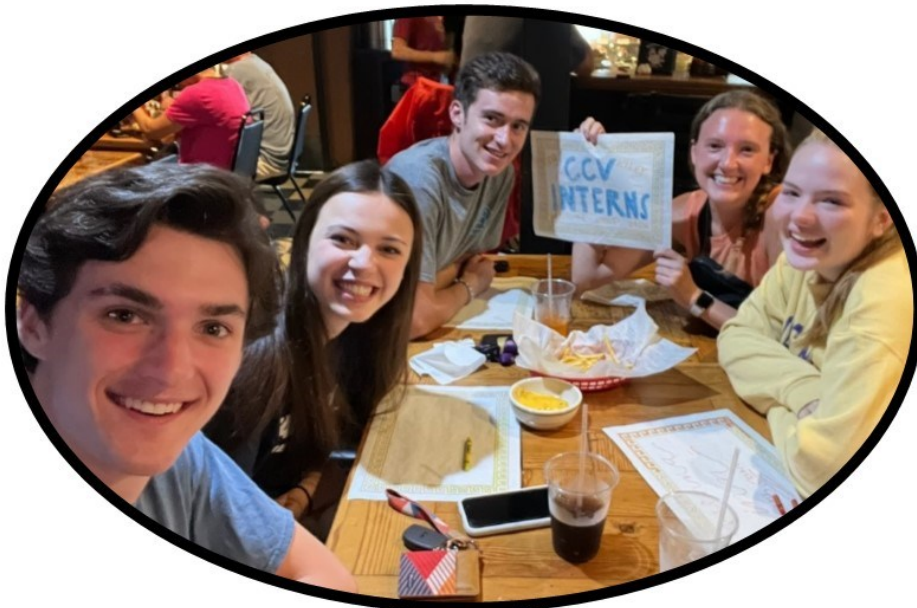
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This summer mission program is designed to expose you to relational student ministry in a local - church based context. You will impact the lives of young adults in Vienna for Jesus Christ. At a time when students are not in school and open to spending time together, we hope to launch you into building relationships that will allow you to encourage students to grow in Christ, and for some, to hear the Gospel for the very first time!

The program will have 2 tracts: One tract will have college aged students be on **CDP STAFF** with CCV. This means your "9-5" job will be as Student Ministry Interns— either with the High School or the Middle School.

The other tract will allow for college aged CDP Participants to be **Marketplace Interns** with CCV. This would mean you have a "9-5" job in the workplace and integrate into the CDP program through community, classes and ministry opportunities in the evenings and on weekends. While both these tracts allow for flexibility in participants summer plans— they also allow for both groups to grow in community and ministry as they study and serve together.

Your weeks will be structured as shown on the next page. This schedule will allow for you to minister and grow through the various opportunities for personal spiritual and professional development. A concurrent goal of this program is to impart to you a ministry philosophy that will not only transform your school year but we hope will ultimately change your life.
